The economy of Grenada is driven by tourism, high-quality agriculture, international academic education, and notably the Citizenship by Investment (CBI) program, which is considered one of the most reputable and sustainable programs in the Caribbean region. While not a tax haven the country does not impose global income tax on non-resident individuals or foreign sources income of tax residents. Grenada is a member of the United Nations (UNO), the Commonwealth, CARICOM, OECS among other international organizations. Since the early 1980ies it enjoys a particularly close and friendly special relationship with the USA.

Regarding international connectivity, Grenada has the Maurice Bishop International Airport, with direct connections to the United States, Canada, the United Kingdom, and mainland Europe through major airlines. Thanks to this, Grenada is not only an ideal tourist destination but also a strategic choice for development.
